## SANE Program

This 40 hour, 4 1/2 day course is designed to give the nurse basic knowledge of the role of the SANE nurse.

## Program Speakers

Many agencies intersect to care for the victim of sexual assault. This course emphasizes this multidisciplinary approach and brings at least 20 experts from many disciplines together to discuss their role with respect to the victim of sexual assault. In addition to the information presented by the co-course coordinators Ellen Johnson, Karine Zakroczymski, and other SANE program personnel, this 40 hour course will include speakers from prosecution, law enforcement, advocacy, BCA, toxicology, psychiatry, and offender treatment. This breadth of speakers is intended to give the SANE a clear idea of the many facets of care provided to the victim of sexual assault and how the SANE role will intersect with each of these agencies. The advantage of offering speakers from two different SANE programs and different counties is to give a broader view of treatment for the victim of sexual assault that is not specific to just one program. SANEs from other programs will also gain knowledge of the care for sexual assault patients that is transferable to any part of the state.

Identify barriers to seeking treatment within various cultural groups

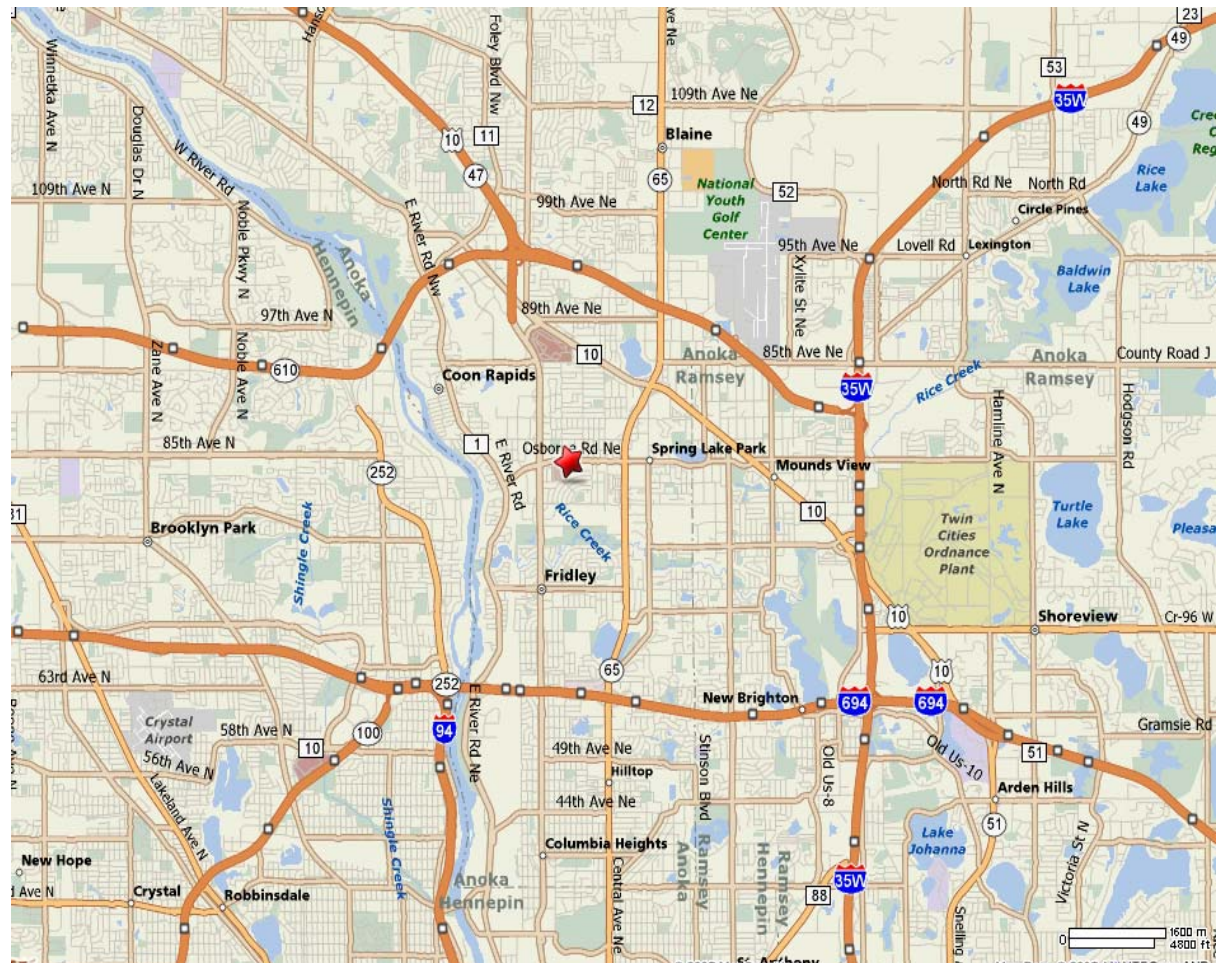
## Directions to Unity Hospital

### From the North

Take 35 W South to US Highway 10 West (Exit 30) to Hwy 65 (Central Av.) Go South on Hwy 65 to Osborne Rd. Turn Right onto Osborne Rd. Go 3/4 mile. Unity Hospital will be on the left. Just before the hospital turn left on Madison St NE. The Lyric Building will be on the left (second driveway). The Course will be held in Classroom C of the Lyric Building.

### From the South

Take 694 to University Av North exit. Take University Av to Osborne Rd and turn right onto Osborne Rd. and go 0.5 miles. On your right will be Unity Hospital. Turn right onto Madison St NE which is just after the hospital. The Lyric Building will be on the left (second driveway). The course will be held in Classroom C of the Lyric Building.
